



## CALL FOR MUSICAL TALENT!

The City of El Paso's Museums and Cultural Affairs Department (MCAD) invites eligible musical groups to apply for consideration to perform during the 11th Annual Chalk the Block Downtown Public Art Festival!

On October 12-14, 2018 the City of El Paso Museums and Cultural Affairs Department (MCAD) in partnership with the El Paso Community Foundation will host Chalk the Block 11 Public Arts Festival (CTB 11). Chalk the Block has become a signature El Paso event that provides an opportunity for the community to experience downtown in a whole new light with amazing sidewalk chalk art competitions, live music, delicious food, an interactive Kids Zone, and large-scale temporary public art installations. Last year, over 42,000 people attended the event.

### ELIGIBILITY

The Chalk the Block 11 Call for Musical Talent is open to all regional musical groups. Organizers are seeking to fill time slots for the main stage throughout the event on October 13. Musical groups selected to participate in CTB 11 will be notified via email by September 14, 2018.

If selected, all musical groups must be flexible and willing to perform during the assigned time slot.

Musical talent will be chosen through a competitive, panel reviewed, application process.

### DEADLINE TO APPLY

All applications must be received by August 27, 2018, 11:30 pm.

**Late and/or incomplete applications will be disqualified. No exceptions will be made.**

## **SELECTED ARTIST RESPONSIBILITIES AND AGREEMENTS**

- CTB is a family-oriented event. Musical groups must refrain from using vulgar or obscene language.
- The musical group agrees to arrive at the scheduled time slot
- MCAD will provide backline only
- Musical groups must fill out vendor paperwork in order to be paid for their performance. All selected participants must have a voided check or letter from banking institution documenting an active checking account in order to receive payment.
- Payment is provided after the performance due to City purchasing regulations.
